Why IS 14489 Compliance Matters Now

India's construction sector is growing fast. Projects worth more than ₹111 lakh crore are underway under the National Infrastructure Pipeline.

Construction accounts for nearly **11 percent of workplace fatalities in India**, and over **48,000 workers die each year due to occupational accidents**. Because of this, authorities are increasing **unplanned safety audits** and tightening enforcement of IS 14489.

For project heads, safety compliance is no longer optional. It directly affects audit outcomes, site continuity, and worker lives.

What IS 14489 Covers

IS 14489 is the Indian Standard Code of Practice for Safety in Construction.

It focuses on:

- Scaffolding and work at height
- Electrical safety
- Personal protective equipment
- Fire safety and emergency response
- Safe material handling and storage
- Worker training and supervision



The goal is simple.

Reduce accidents and build a strong safety culture on construction sites.

High-Risk Areas Auditors Focus On

During an IS 14489 audit, inspectors pay close attention to:

- Scaffolding stability and access
- PPE availability and actual usage
- Electrical earthing and temporary connections
- Fire extinguishers, signage, and evacuation routes
- Safety training records and inductions
- Site housekeeping and material storage

Weakness in any one area can trigger observations or penalties.

7-Step IS 14489 Audit Preparation Framework

Step 1: Pre-Audit Site Assessment

Walk the site with a compliance mindset. Identify visible gaps before auditors do.

Step 2: Documentation Review

Ensure safety policies, SOPs, risk assessments, and training records are updated and signed.

Step 3: Physical Safety Checks

Inspect scaffolding, electrical systems, PPE, and fire safety equipment.

Step 4: Safety Training Readiness

Confirm inductions, toolbox talks, and task-based training are conducted and recorded.

Step 5: Workforce Engagement

Involve workers through toolbox talks, safety committees, and feedback systems.

Step 6: Mock Audits

Conduct internal or external mock audits to simulate real inspection conditions.

Step 7: Audit-Day Preparation

Assign a site contact, organize documents, brief workers, and keep the site orderly.

Essential Documents Auditors Expect



Keep these ready and accessible:

- Safety policy and standard operating procedures
- Risk assessment and hazard identification reports
- Training and induction records
- Equipment inspection and maintenance logs
- Incident, accident, and near-miss reports
- Emergency response and evacuation plans

Missing or outdated documents are one of the most common audit failure reasons.
